The McDowell Rural Heritage Quilt Trail, a part of McDowell Arts Council Association, is funded by grants supported by fundraising activities, donations, raffles, and business grants. The main goal of the McDowell Rural Heritage Quilt Trail is the preservation and promotion of the rural history of McDowell County.

Requirements for McDowell Rural Heritage Quilt Trail Host

1. Building should be rural in nature, not necessarily in a rural setting, with older building having higher priority.
2. Building should remain in reasonably good structural condition through the life of the block.
3. Obstructions (vines, bushes, trees, etc.) should be kept from interfering with the view of the block.
4. Building must be in a location where the public can view the block.
5. The block will remain on the building at least eight years with no changes to the block. If the block needs to be moved, refurbished, or ownership of the building changes, the McDowell Quilt Trail should be notified.
6. Building owner will allow the block to be photographed from public highway. Entry to private property is authorized only by property owner.
7. The block will be provided to the building owner through the Rural Heritage Quilt Trail Grant.
8. Working with the building owner, the block design will be determined by the McDowell Quilt Trail Committee. The committee will consider any traditional pieced quilt block design that the owner may suggest.
9. The McDowell Quilt Trail Committee, after considering all requests, will be the sole authority for determining the host building, block design, and block size.
10. The building owner agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the McDowell Arts Council Association as well as its officers, committees, agents, and employees for and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses, and causes of action related to the quilt block.
